

## Helpful Information for Those Who Print and Distribute (ID 302) Petitions

- To print a valid petition signature sheet:
  - Use 20#, plain, white, copy paper (we used Office Depot copiers and paper).
  - **It is essential** to place the two sides of the petition sheet **correctly**: The petition must be printed double-sided. If you hold the top of the cover sheet and turn it over, you should see the left side of the 10-line signature page at the top.
- Read carefully “Instructions for Circulators” and “Instructions for Signers” on the actual petition sheet.
  - The Secretary of State requires that every Circulator must:
    - At all times have a physical copy present of all 3 pages of HB 2681 while collecting signatures;
    - Ask each person, “Are you an active registered voter in Oregon who has not yet signed this petition?” Have them sign using their registered voting address.
    - Always guard the petition sheet. You **must watch** each person who signs the sheet. Don’t leave it unattended.
    - As a circulator, only sign the bottom of the petition when you are finished gathering signatures for that page. Your date must be the same or later than anyone on that page.
- If distributing petitions to other circulators, give petition sheets only to *trustworthy people you know who request petition sheets*. If you are mailing out sheets, include with them:
  - a copy of House Bill 2681;
  - a card or note with information about [www.cleanvoterrolls.com](http://www.cleanvoterrolls.com), phone number (503-757-0670), and where to mail the completed sheets: Cheryl Bowen: 16587 NE Hoyt Terrace, Portland, OR 97230. Her address is also on the petition sheet.
    - **NOTE:** Record the names, number of sheets, and contact information of circulators you give the sheets to and follow up to see if they have questions and have sent them in. It is very helpful to keep a weekly running record of how many signatures are being collected.
- Additional Suggestions for Circulators:
  - Be safe: Work with another circulator in friendly areas.
  - If at all possible, use another sheet of paper and ask signers if they would be willing to write down their name, phone, email, and zip code. The reason for this is to build a data base of solid conservatives. We are not allowed to copy any information from the signature sheets. Therefore, the need for an additional sheet of paper.
